Overview:

Wells Fargo is committed to community organizations like First Tee[®] that help to create a brighter future for young people. Our annual *Succeeding Together* program celebrates the huge impact the First Tee[®] has on students across the country and allows participants to express how the First Tee[®] has had a positive effect on their lives.

Event Details:

Eligible participants of First Tee can enter a contest for the opportunity to win a trip for two to attend the Wells Fargo Championship PGA TOUR event in Charlotte, N.C. **Do not enter this Contest if you are not able to accept a Grand or First prize if you win. You and your parent or legal guardian (or other designated individual 25 years of age or older) must be able to travel 4/28/2020 – 5/1/2020 (Grand Prize trip) or 5/1/2020 – 5/4/2020 (First Prize trips).**

Participant Selection:

Ten Finalists will be selected to win \$500 cash. From the Finalists, four winners will be chosen to travel to Charlotte to attend the Championship; one Grand Prize winner and three First Prize winners along with one guest each. The Grand Prize winner will also have the opportunity to play in the tournament's pro-am with a PGA TOUR player of their choice (subject to the player's availability). The three First Prize winners will receive an on-course experience at the Tournament, complete with "inside the ropes" access on the course.

Eligibility:

For participants of The First Tee to be eligible to apply for the 2020 Wells Fargo Succeeding TogetherSM Contest they must meet ALL of the following requirements:

- Participants must be between 14 and 18 years old (applicants must reach their 14th birthday by the first day of the event date and not have reached their 19th birthday by the conclusion of the event)
- Classified as a high school freshman, sophomore, junior or senior as of spring semester 2020
- Entered in Salesforce and has been an active participant for a minimum of three years
- Must be at Birdie level or higher, at the time of application deadline
- Chapters must have signed their contract at least 3 years before application deadline in order to submit applicants
- Acceptable Golf Ability – USGA handicap of 18 or better
- If selected, the participant and their chaperone (must be 25 years of age or older) must be able to travel 4/28/2020 – 5/1/2020 (Grand Prize trip) or 5/1/2020 – 5/4/2020 (First Prize trips).
- Participants who attended the event previously are not eligible to apply



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Application Process

The deadline to apply is 11:59 p.m. PST on March 3, 2020

Please follow the instructions in the "Quick Start Guide" on how to complete this process. The application will consist of the following:

- Create an account (if you do not already have one) on the Website.
- Application Code – available from a First Tee Chapter staff member
- General Information Form
- Three (3) Typed Essays responding to the Contest Questions (no less than 200 words each)
- Golf Resume (not judged)
- Headshot (not judged - to be uploaded by the participant)
- Authorization and Release form

Below is a copy of the application you will need to complete online; please refer to the application below to make sure that you have all of the information you need to complete your application.

Selection Process:

Following the close of the contest, a judging committee made up of home office staff, chapter staff and Wells Fargo staff will review the essays and identify the ten finalists by assigning point values to the categories. First and Grand Prize winners will be notified by telephone by the Contest Administrator for Wells Fargo on March 16, 2020 and (subject to completion of the verification process) and posted on the website on March 24, 2020.
