



David Rimmer Scholarship

The David Rimmer Scholarship was created in the memory of David Rimmer, an assistant golf professional who loved junior golf.

This is a competitive process of application that will be based on an applicant's academic achievement, community involvement and commitment to First Tee - North Florida. Applications will be used to select up to two participants of First Tee - North Florida as David Rimmer scholarship recipients.

The scholarship recipients will receive a one-time (\$ TBD) scholarship provided they uphold the eligibility terms outlined below.

Eligibility

Applications from seniors enrolled in High School will be submitted, participants must meet the following minimum requirements to be eligible to apply:

- Classified and enrolled as a high school senior
- Preferred GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale*
- Successful completion of Birdie class
- Entered in First Tee - North Florida participant database at a minimum of Three years or more
- Active and current in The First Tee database upon submittal of application
- Accepted in an accredited college or university

*Although this program is not based upon academic standing, proficiency in school will be taken into consideration.

Deadlines

- March 31st - Application Postmark Deadline. ALL ORIGINAL SIGNED DOCUMENTS MUST BE IN THE MAIL BY THIS DATE. INCOMPLETE OR PARTIAL APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED NOR RETURNED FOR COMPLETION.
